### **Material Handling Abilities**

#### **Functional Abilities to Job Demands Match**

This client had a Workers Compensation Initial Therapy Evaluation performed on 10/25/2019 and at this time he/she demonstrated the ability to perform 9.1% of physical demands of his/her job. This Functional Progress Note was performed on 11/2/2019 and this client demonstrated the ability to perform 45.9% of the physical demands of their job as a Truck Driver. This is a 36.8% increase in return-to-work function since the previous return-to-work test was performed. The return to work test items this client was unable to achieve successfully during this evaluation include: Occasional Squat Lifting, Occasional Shoulder Lifting, Occasional Unilateral Lifting, Occasional Bilateral Carrying, Occasional Unilateral Carrying, Occasional Pushing, Simple Grasping, Firm Grasping and Crawling.
